It could be things like loss of a loved one, childhood trauma, depression, anxiety, ADHD, OCD, or other mental health issues. Look for a therapist for those reasons. Research shows a connection between other issues and hoarding. A therapist is only part of a team effort to help someone who is hoarding. Consider also using a professional organizer or a support group.

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Removal Services, Clean Out, Sell, Contractors, and or Home Resellers

Removal services or cleanout company role: Remove a lot of belongings in a day or two. Homeowner may or may not have input into what is removed, depending on involvement of public officials. Junk haulers take the load to a warehouse where they sort out what can be recycled, sold, or reused; they trash what is left.
